## ■ Lisa Driscoll, Secretary

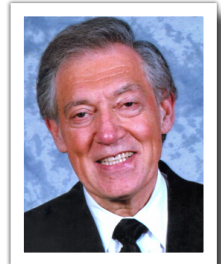
